Stop Loan Sharks



DON'T GET BITTEN BY A LOAN SHARK

Have you borrowed money but not got any paper work?
Does your loan keep growing but you've been making payments?
Have you been threatened when you couldn't pay?
Had your cash card or benefit book taken off you?

If the answer is yes to one of these YOU may have borrowed money off an ILLEGAL MONEY LENDING LOAN SHARK.

Illegal money lending is a crime. To check to see if your money lender is legal or to report illegal money lending and get help stopping the payments the Illegal Money Lending Team is here to help you:-

Ring them on 0300 555 2222 or text 'loan (space) shark (space) + your message to 60003 or email stoploansharks@manchester.gov.uk

Get a loan from a legal and trustworthy money lender – go to the Manchester Credit Union and ask about a loan today. They offer affordable weekly repayments and it won't cost you the earth. The Wythenshawe branch of the credit union shop is now open in the Civic Shopping Centre (opposite Home Bargains) – pop in today and have a chat with one of the advisors.
